2019 Accomplishments, 2020 Goals





LAST YEAR YOUR DONATIONS HELPED US:

- Assist 1,434 adults and children impacted by incarceration.
- Prepare 333 clients with criminal records for a successful job search.
- Support 227 families with incarcerated loved ones.
- Provide in-school support groups in 18 CMS schools to 208 kids with incarcerated parents. 88% of children showed increase in social and emotional growth.
- Launch an After School Tutoring program for kids affected by incarceration.
- House and provide programming to 52 incarcerated women during their transition back to the community.
- Provide trauma and substance use support groups to 55 people with criminal records; also assist 41 clients with chronic diseases and/or mental health issues.
- Lower the chance of recidivism for our LifeWorks! clients. Our recidivism rates were 17% after one year.

To continue to reduce recidivism, lessen burdens on families and support returning community members, we need to raise \$50,000 by December 31, 2019.

WITH YOUR HELP WE CAN ACHIEVE THESE GOALS IN 2020:

SUPPORT FAMILIES IMPACTED BY INCARCERATION

- Provide meals and support for hundreds of families at 11 Third Tuesday Family Support Nights.
- 100+ children with incarcerated parents will be able to participate in quarterly enrichment field trips.
- 225+ kids will benefit from in-school support groups and 40+ from our After School tutoring program.
- 85% of caretakers will show an increase in personal resilience to better support their children's development.

HELP WOMEN IN TRANSITION

- Cover tuition, fees, and materials for incarcerated women choosing to pursue a college education.
- Updates to improve safety and wear and tear at the Women's Facility, now more than 10 years old.
- Start a recreational fund for 30 women living at our Center for Women so they can participate in activities keeping them healthy and happy.

EMPLOYMENT RESOURCES & SUPPORT

- Employment Readiness classes to 360 formerly incarcerated men and women; 80% will find employment.
- Public transportation assistance to clients so they can attend job trainings and interviews.
- Job retention training to 288 men and women so 90% will stay employed.
- Connect 72 individuals who have chronic and/or mental illnesses with essential medical care; as a result, at least 50% will also become employed!
